NOTE ABOUT MEDICAID:

First and foremost, if you earn below the 138% federal poverty level AND you are a resident/citizen of the US, you may qualify for Medicaid.

If that is the case, we would need a letter of denial from Medicaid to accept you as a new patient. Otherwise, we can only accept you for three months while you apply to Medicaid.

FSC ELIGIBILITY

- Be a Loudoun County resident for at least 6 consecutive months
- Be between the ages 18 - 64
- Have no health insurance
- Have an income level that falls within 200% of the Federal Poverty Level based on the number of people in your household



Once you've done the first part of the application here, we will contact you to schedule the second part: an in-person eligibility meeting.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

NOTE ABOUT HOMELESSNESS OR LAWS or LOUDOUN SHELTER:

We need a letter from the shelter stating when you started living there and what monetary support they provide.

At our eligibility meetings, you must provide:

- Photo ID
- A bill or mail correspondence dated 6 months ago or more--proves you've been living in Loudoun for at least 6 months
- Unexpired lease agreement or last mortgage bill with your name on it.
 - Or, a letter from the person from whom you rent that states their name and phone number, date agreement began, how much you pay and the address (**must be notarized**)
- Last four pay stubs.
 - If no pay stubs because paid in cash, need letter from employer stating how much you earn a week (gross) including tips (**notarized letter**)
 - If no income, need letter from person who pays your bills stating what they help you pay (what money they provide) (**notarized letter**)
- Bank statements from the past three months
- Taxes: we need your current year tax documents.
 - If you haven't filed, we need last year's, plus the W2s you were mailed this year.
 - If you do not file at all, we will have you sign a letter of release from the IRS so we can verify it.
- If you have dependents that are over the age of 18, they have to be listed as dependents in your taxes otherwise, we cannot count them towards family size.
 - If you are a dependent, we need to see the taxes of the person on whom you depend.
